Foreword

Development of a robust information system is critical for successful planning, monitoring and implementation of any programme, particularly in the social sector. It has always been our endeavour to strengthen the Educational Management Information System (EMIS). EMIS has been accorded top priority from the very beginning of the *Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan* programme launched in 2001. District Information System for Education (DISE) developed by the National University of Educational Planning and Administration (NUEPA), New Delhi has been extended to all States & UTs and districts of the country. The depth of DISE coverage has increased over the years.

In the light of the recommendations of the Expert Group on Creation of Unified System of Data Collection for School Education Statistics, efforts for a unified school data collection system was made for first time in 2012-13, covering elementary & secondary schools. The present publication is an outcome of the second year of unified school based data for elementary and secondary schools which is a massive exercise. I am also happy that the Ministry's statistical publications on school education will henceforth be based on UDISE data.

UDISE has become a regular source of information on all aspects of elementary and secondary education. School-specific UDISE data is also being made available to many users, researchers, educationists and implementators. Annually, a set of seven publications including 'District and State Report Cards', web-enabled 'Elementary Education in Rural and Urban India', 'UDISE Flash Statistics including Educational Development Index', and 'Elementary Education in India: Progress towards Universal Elementary Education (UEE), Analytical Tables', are brought out regularly, for wide scale dissemination and use.

I thank Prof. R. Govinda, Vice-Chancellor, NUEPA, Dr. Arun C Mehta, Professor and Head, Department of EMIS and the entire DISE team, for bringing out the present publication.

Keeping this in view NUEPA is making a concerted effort to provide a unified system of school education statistics for all levels of schooling from elementary to higher secondary education. The present publication is outcome of this effort through which information from about 1.52 million schools have been collected.

It is, indeed, a great pleasure for me to present a summary data base on elementary education in India through present publication. Including this publication, NUEPA brings out on annual basis seven publications exclusively based on DISE data under the following titles: (a) DISE Flash Statistics: Elementary Education in India, Progress towards UEE; (b) Elementary Education in India: Where Do We Stand; District & State Report Cards; (c) Analytical Tables; and (d) Elementary Education in Rural & Urban India all of which are available at www.dise.in for the last nine years. Thematic Maps and Graphic Presentation based on DISE data have also been recently brought out.

I take this opportunity to thank Prof. Arun C. Mehta and his team for their commitment and hard work in producing the various publications and sustaining that effort over the years.

I hope that researchers, policy makers, administrators and planners will find the publication both informative and useful.

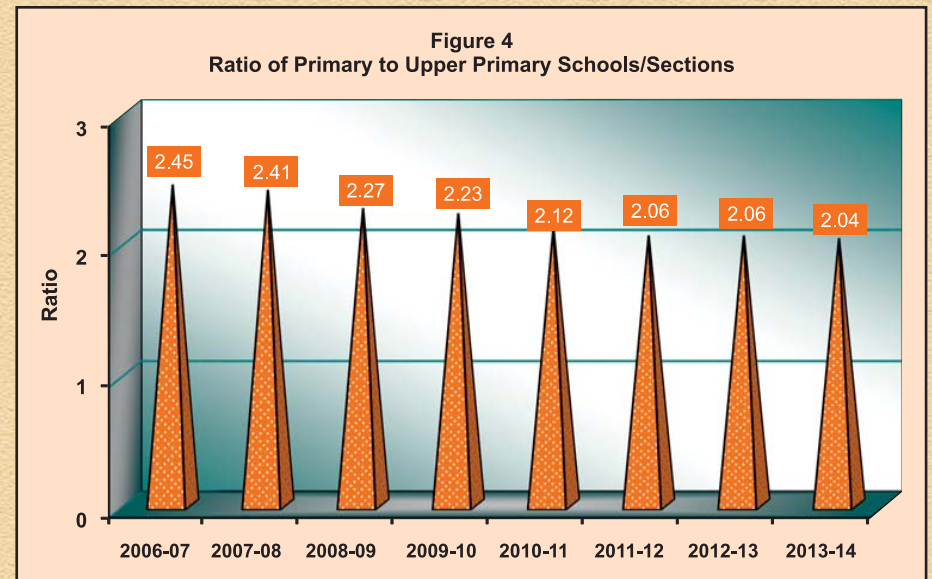
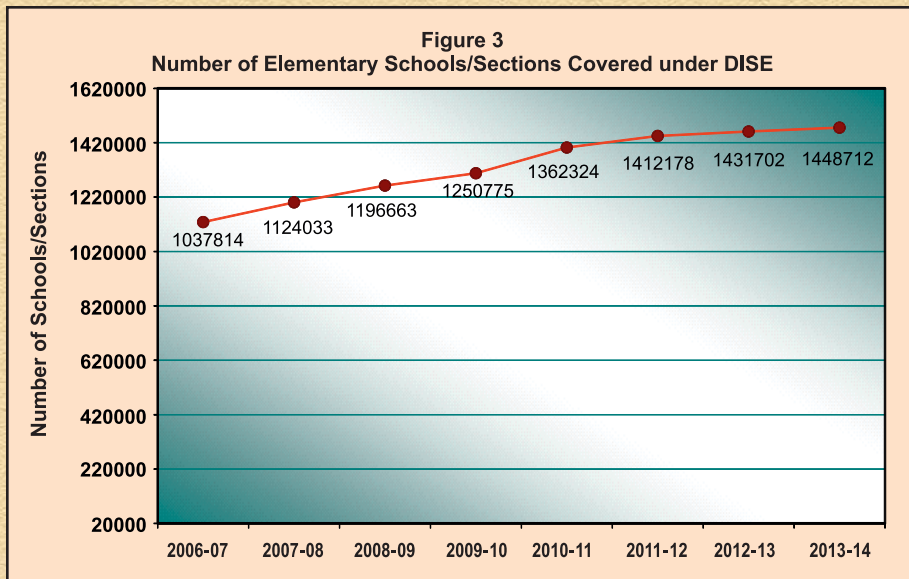
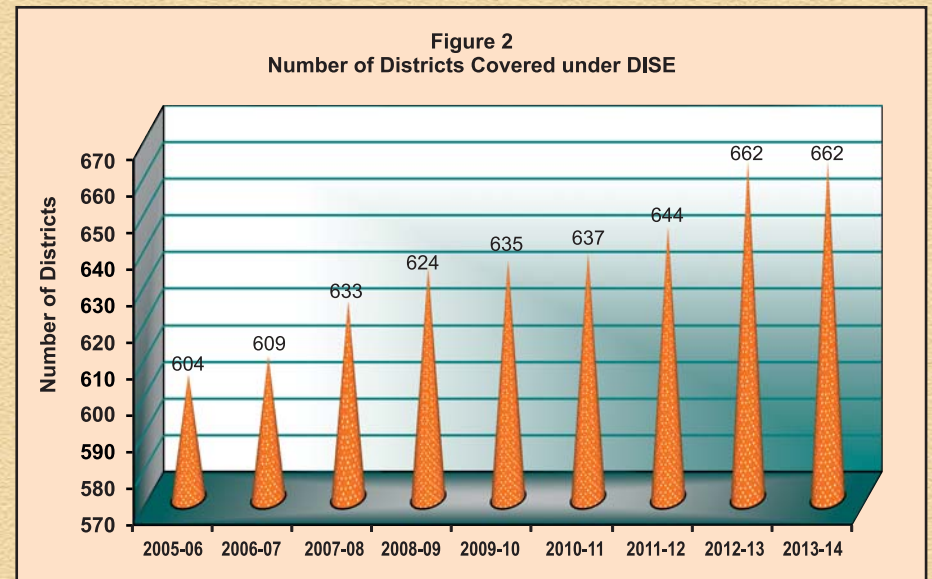
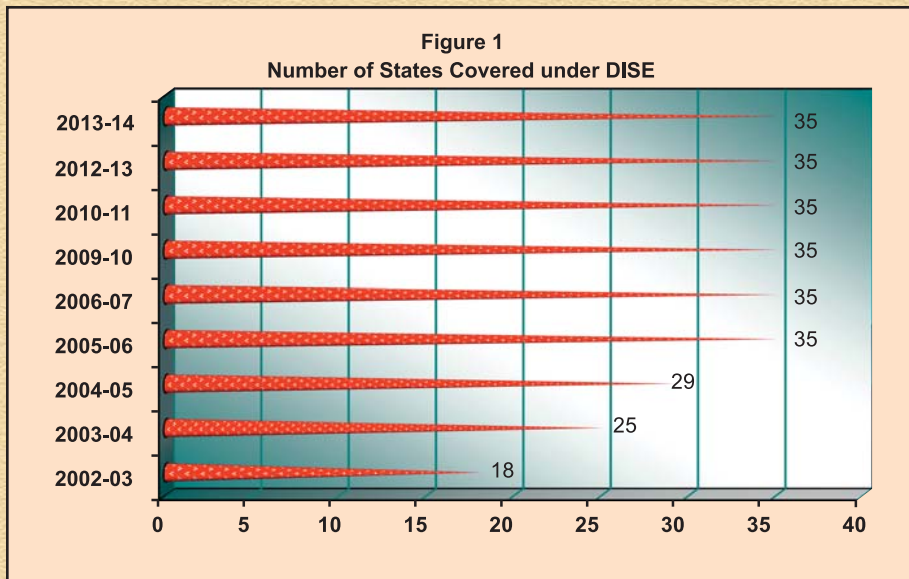

Kitchen-Shed, Playground and Boudary Wall

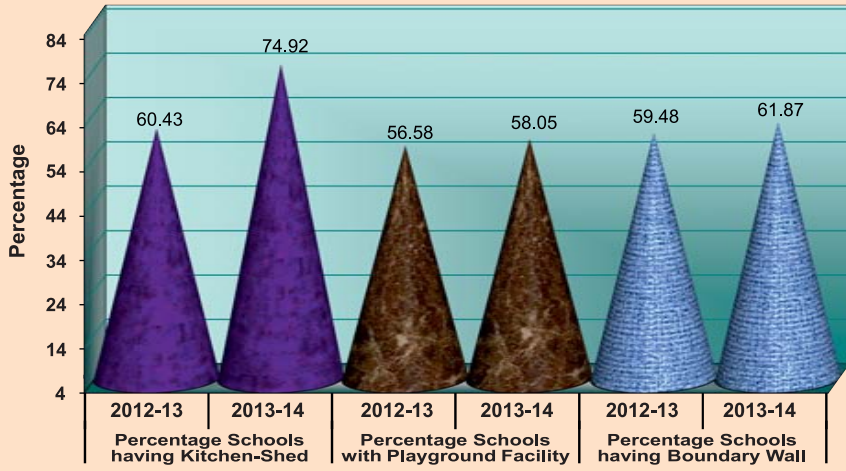

Percentage of Schools having Drinking Water Facility: All Schools

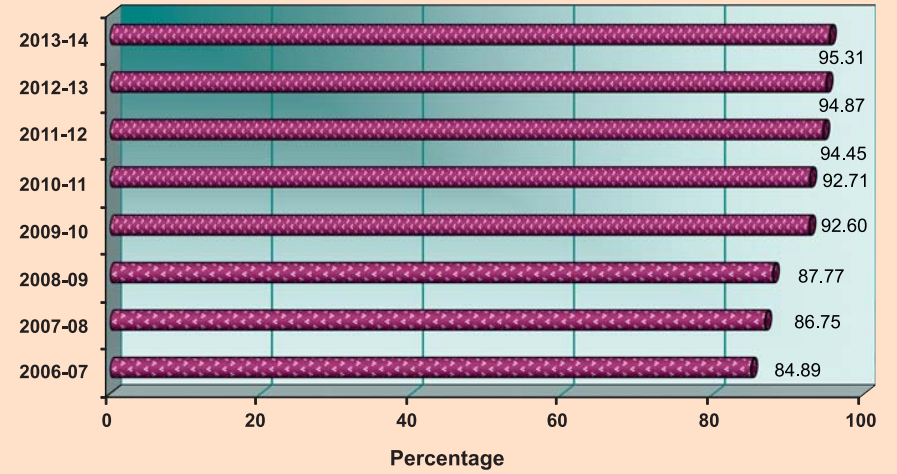

Percentage of Schools having Toilet Facility : All Schools, 2013-14

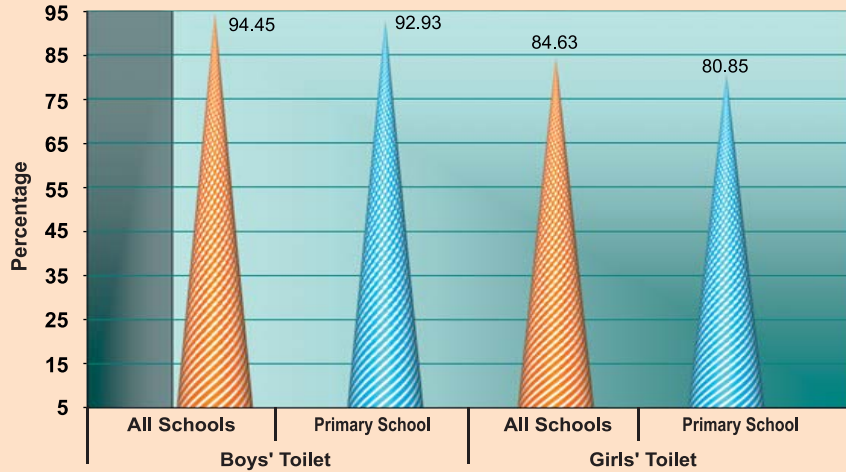
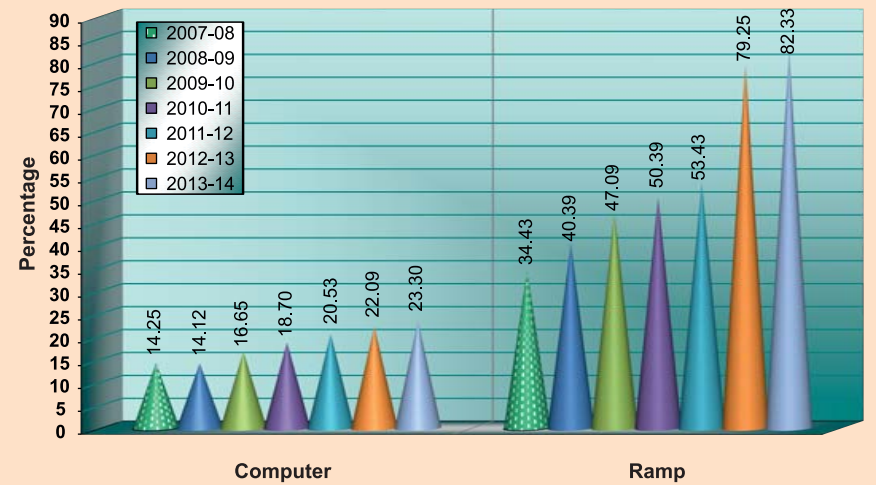

Percentage of Schools having Computer & Ramp Facilities : All Schools



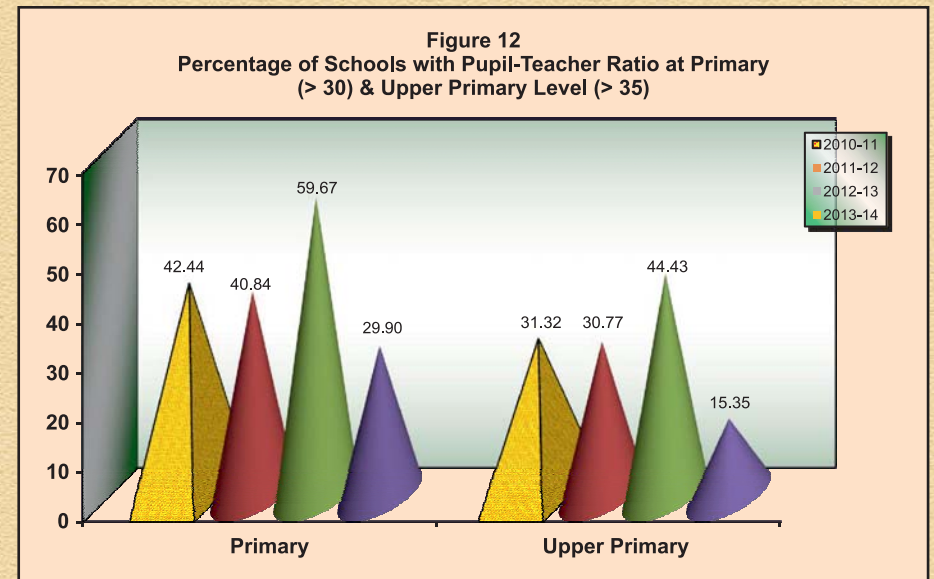
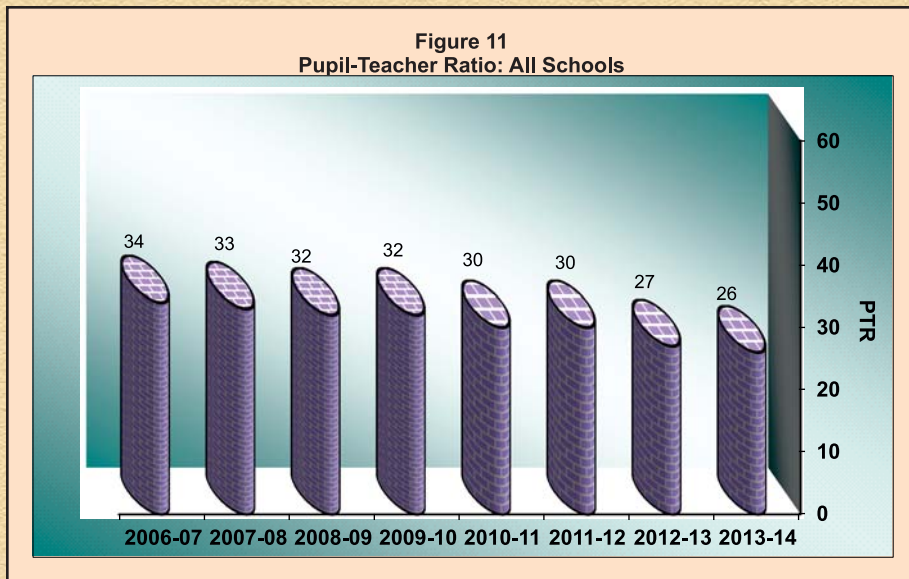
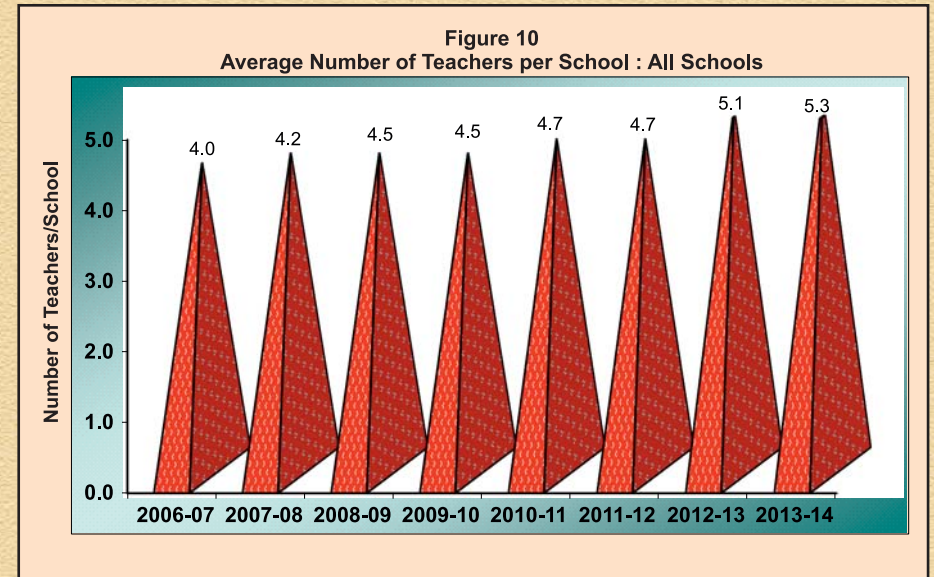
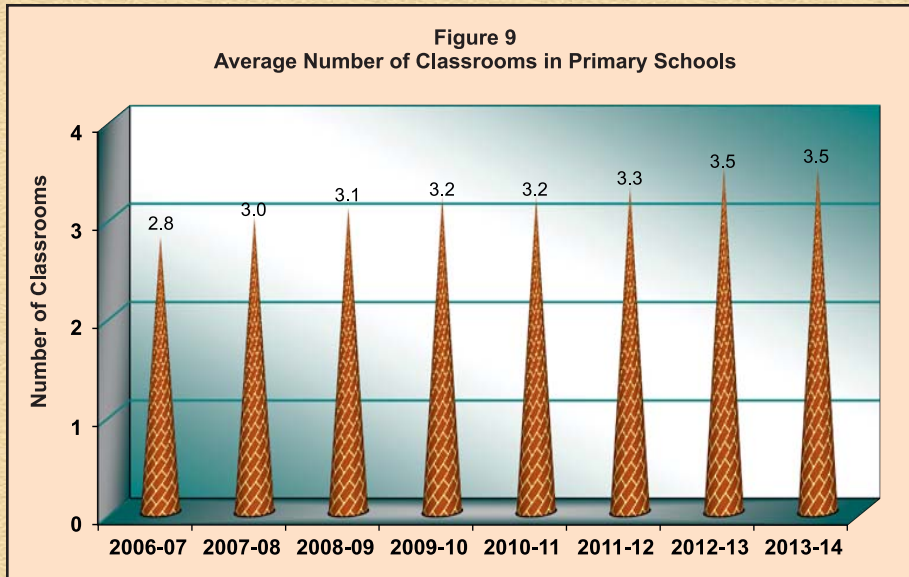

Percentage of Single-Teacher Schools : All Schools

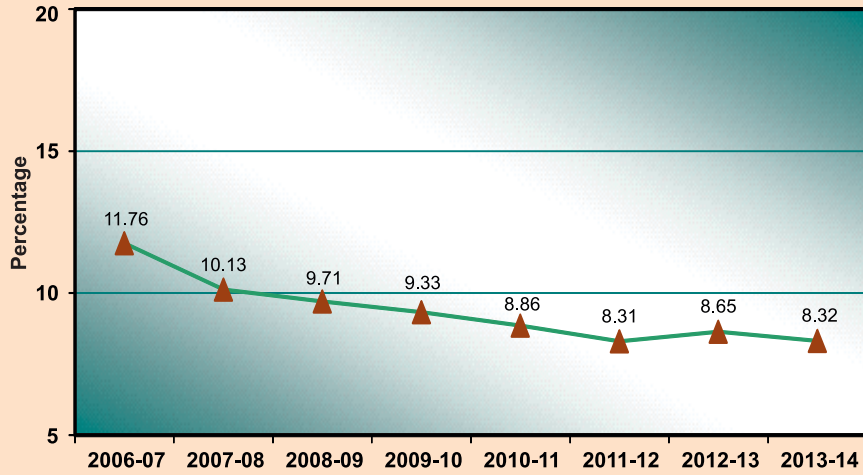

Student-Classroom Ratio : All Schools

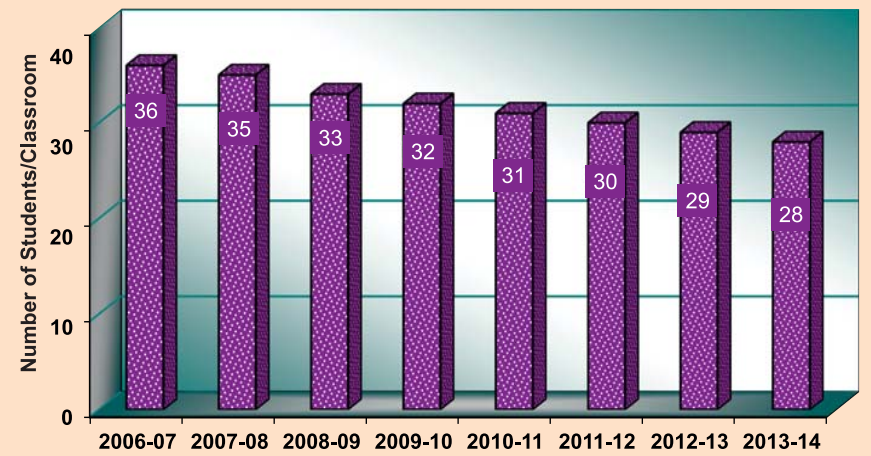

Average Number of Classrooms by Management: All Schools

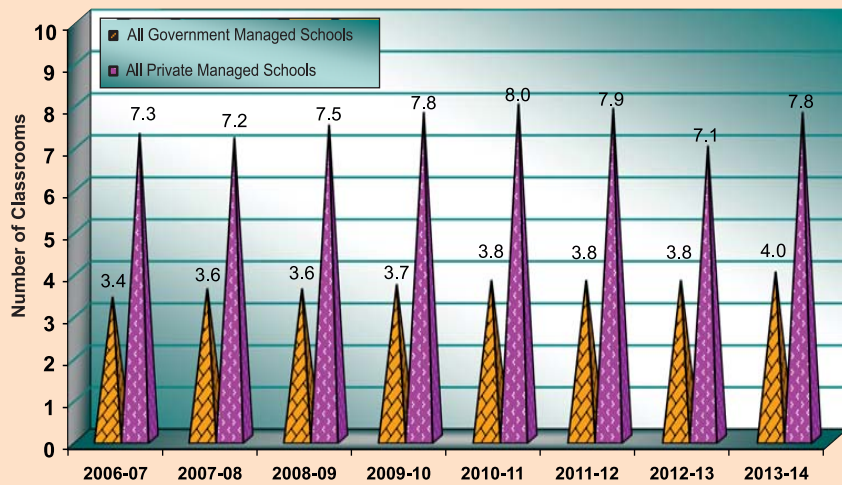

Percentage of Schools with Student-Classroom Ratio at Primary (> 30) & Upper Primary Level (> 35)

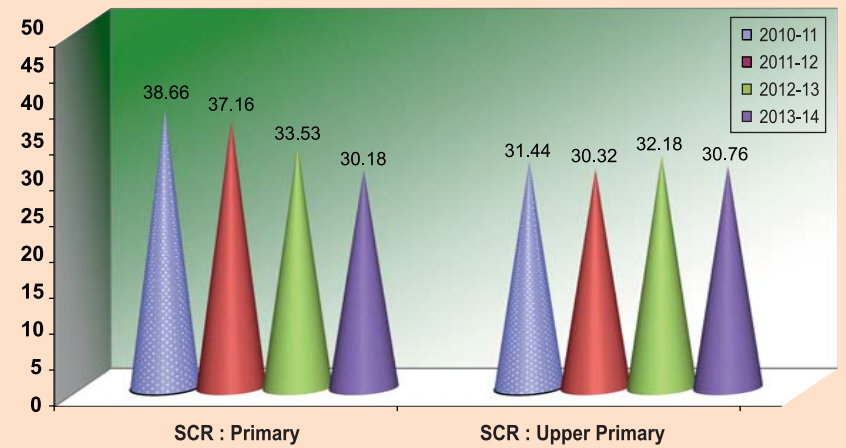

Percentage Distribution of Female Teachers

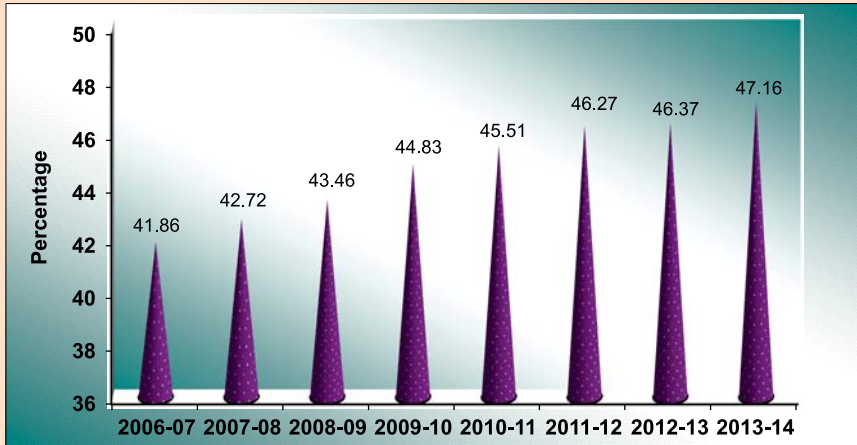

Percentage of Contractual-Teachers to Total Teachers : All Schools

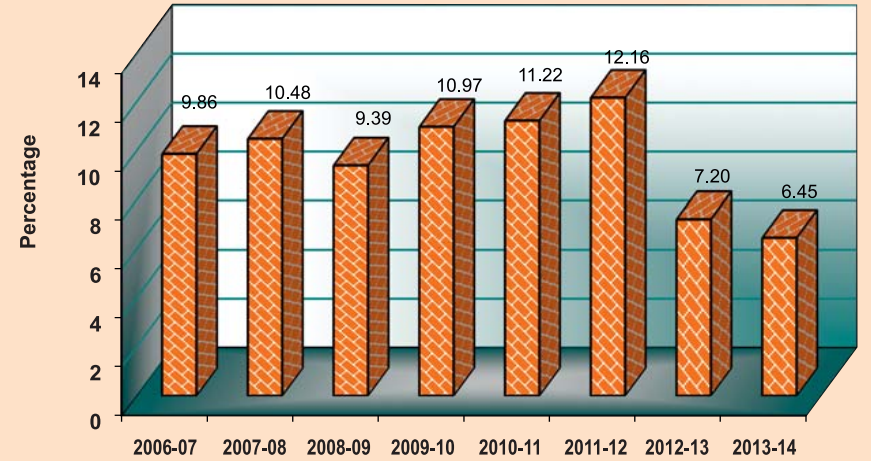

Percentage of Professionally Trained Teachers

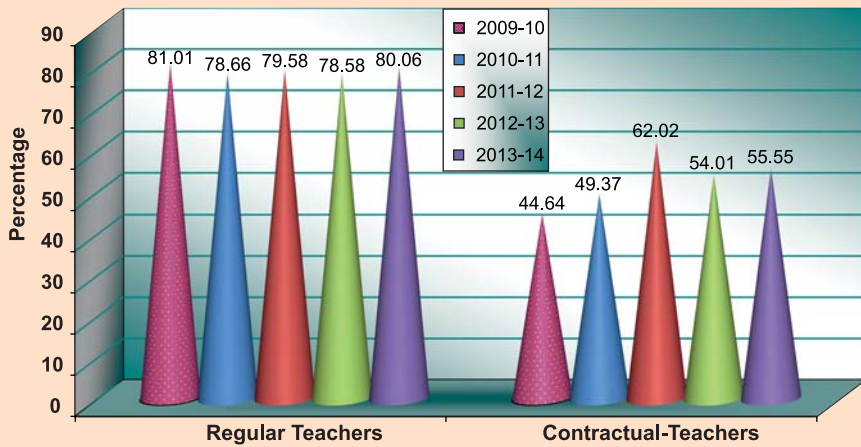

Share of Enrolment in Pre-Primary Classes to Total Primary Enrolment

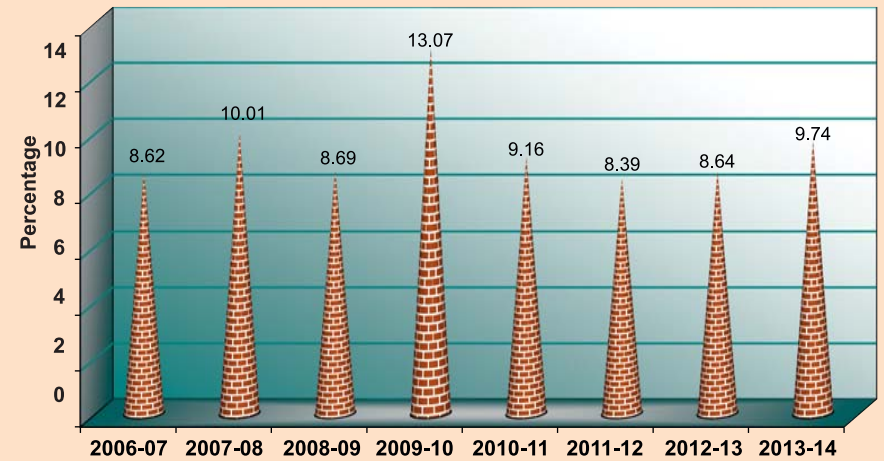
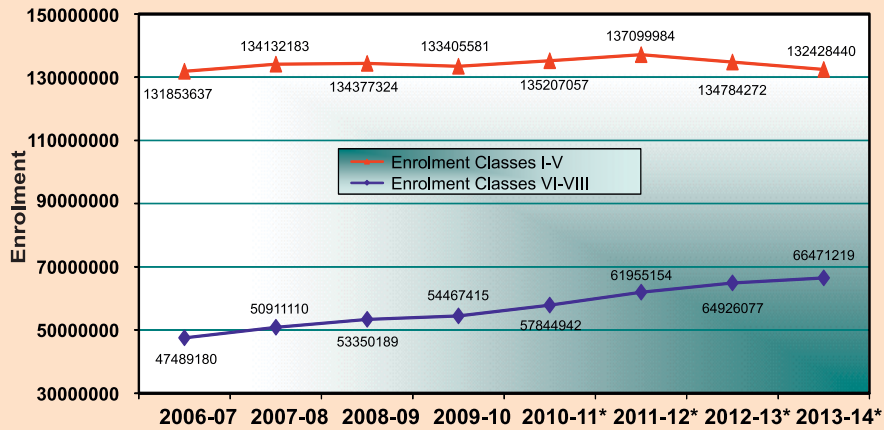

Percentage of Enrolment by Caste : Classes I-VIII

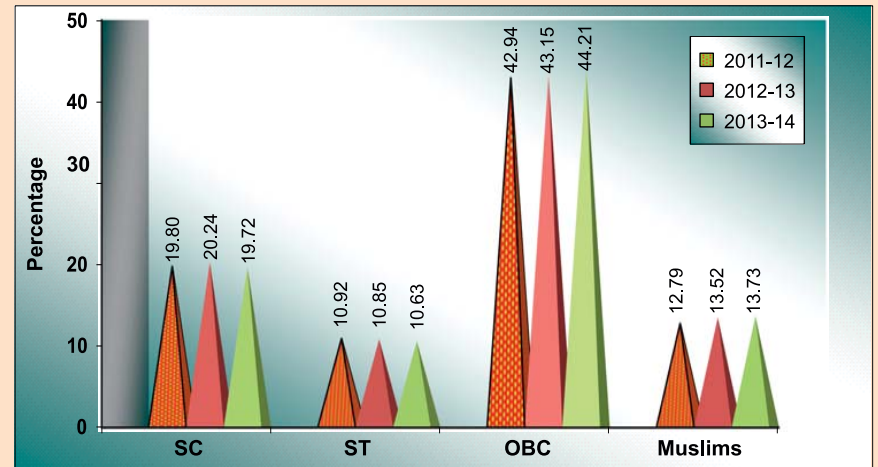

Percentage of Girls Enrolment : Classes I-V

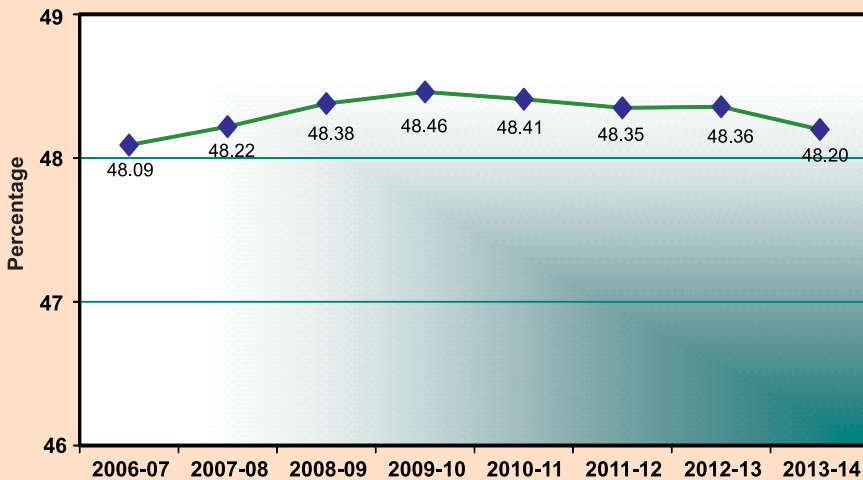

Ratio of Girl's to Boy's Enrolment at Primary and Upper Primary Level

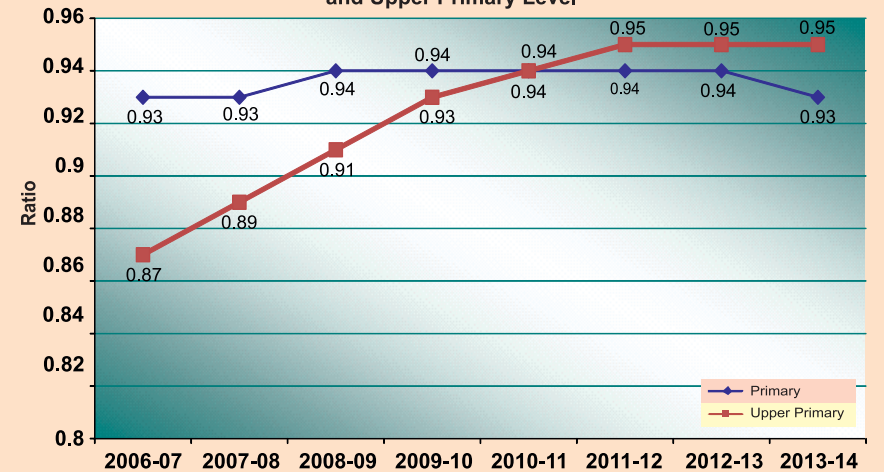
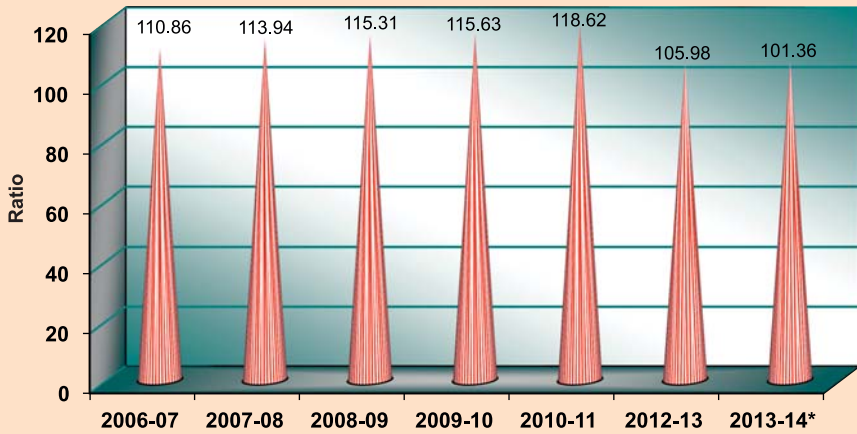

Ratio of Grade V to Grade I Enrolment

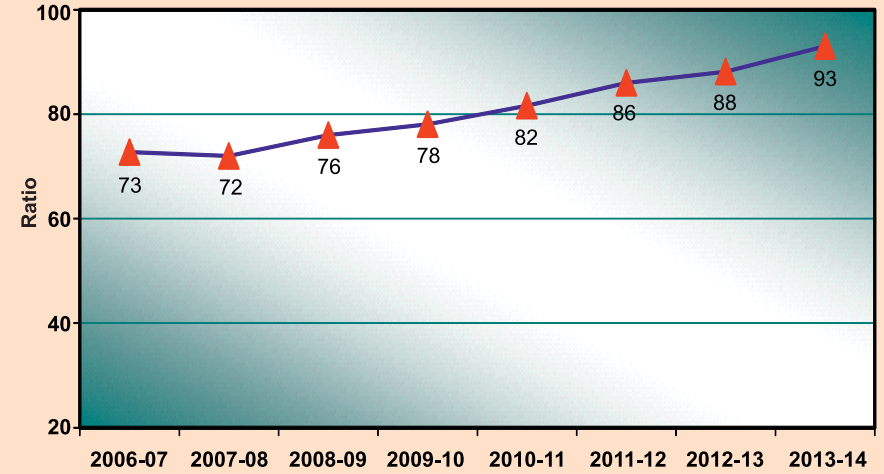

Retention Rate at Primary Level

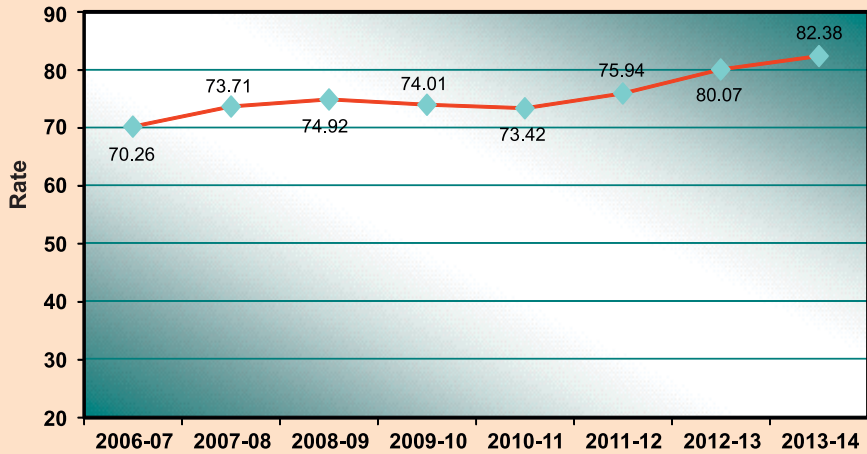
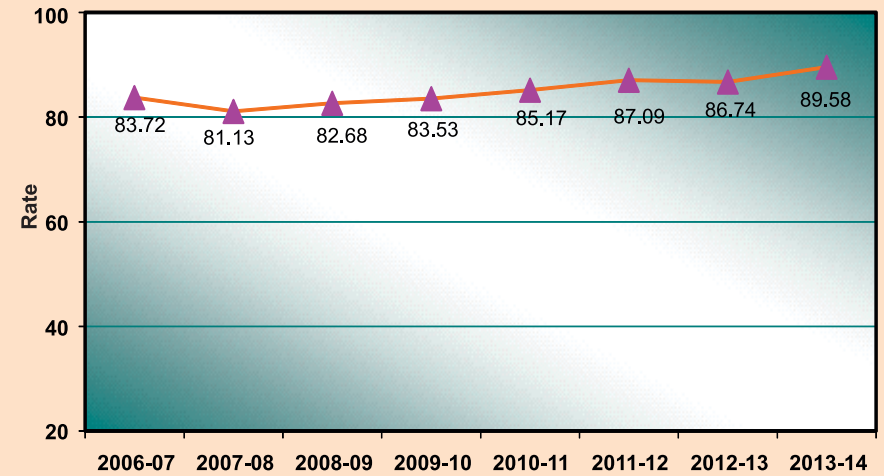

Definitions

Government Managements: Includes schools managed by the Department of Education, Tribal & Social Welfare Departments, Local Body, Central Government, Other Government Managements and No Response (if any).

Private Managements: Includes schools managed by the Private Aided and Private unaided managements.

Gross Enrolment Ratio: Total enrolment in primary education (Grades I-V), regardless of age, expressed as a percentage of the eligible official primary school-age population (6+ to 10+ years) in a given school-year.

Net Enrolment Ratio: Enrolment in primary education (Grades I-V) of the official primary school age group (6+ to 10+ years) expressed as a percentage of the corresponding population.

Age-specific Enrolment Ratio: Enrolment of a specific single-age/age-group (i.e. 6+ to 10+ years) enrolled, irrespective of the level of education, as a percentage of the population of the same age/age-group.

Repetition Rate (Grade-specific): Proportion of pupils from a cohort enrolled in a given grade at a given school year who study in the same grade in the following school year.

Grade-specific Drop-out Rate: Proportion of pupils from a cohort enrolled in a given grade at a given school year who are no longer enrolled in the following school year. This is calculated by using grade-wise enrolment in 2012-13 and 2013-14 and grade-specific number of repeaters in 2013-14.

Average Drop-out Rate: Presents average of grade-specific drop-out rates in Primary Grades and is calculated by using the standard methods by considering grade-wise enrolment in 2012-13 and 2013-14 and grade-specific number of repeaters in 2013-14.

Retention Rate: Enrolment in Grade V (*minus repeaters*) in a year as a proportion to enrolment in Grade I four years back is termed as retention rate at the primary level.

Transition Rate: The number of pupils admitted (new entrants) to the first grade of a higher level of education in a given year, expressed as a percentage of number of pupils enrolled in the final grade of the lower level of education (i.e. Grade V) in the previous year.

Gross Completion Rate (Primary): Primary completion rate is the total number of students regardless of age in the last grade of primary school (Grade V), minus the number of repeaters in that grade, divided by the number of children of the official graduation age (age '10+').

Population Projections: Wherever necessary, projected child population provided by the Planning, Monitoring and Statistics Cell, Department of Higher Education, Ministry of Human Resource Development has been used.

- Indicators used for constructing EDI initially were pre-determined by the MHRD, Government of India. Contributions received from the members of the Multi-Disciplinary Expert and Core Group on EDI constituted by the MHRD in 2005-06 is gratefully acknowledged.
- Indicators were normalised before the Principal Component Analysis was applied to decide the factor loadings and weights.
- Separate dimensional indices were constructed first before finalising the EDI.
- All indicators used in computing EDI are based on DISE data.
- * In previous years, it was referred as Gender Parity Index in enrolment.

Assumptions used in Computing EDI

An effort has been made by the National University of Educational Planning and Administration (NUEPA) and the Government of India (MHRD, Department of School Education and Literacy) to compute an Educational Development Index (EDI), separately for Primary and Upper Primary levels of education and also a composite index for the entire Elementary education which is exclusively based on the DISE data for the year 2013-14. The first such attempt was made in 2005-06.

A set of 24 indicators have been used in computing EDI which are re-grouped into the four sub-groups, namely Access, Infrastructure, Teachers and Outcome indicators. The Indicators used for constructing EDI were pre-determined by a Working Group on EDI constituted by the MHRD during 2005-06 of which NUEPA was also one of the institutional members. There is no change in indicators this year as the same set of indicators used in 2012-13 has also been used in 2013-14.

From last year, some indicators are newly introduced, some are deleted or modified. Percentage of habitations not served, percentage of schools with less than 2 teachers (in schools with more than 15 students) (Primary schools only), percentage of schools with < 3 teachers (Upper Primary schools/sections), repetition rate and ratio of exit class over Class I enrolment (Primary stage) have been removed. Newly introduced indicators are density of schools per 10 Sq. Km., percentage of classroom-teacher ratio 1:1, percentage of schools with kitchen-shed (Government and Aided School), percentage of single-teacher schools, average number of instructional days, average working hours for teachers, percentage change in enrolment in Government schools over the previous year and participation of Muslim children. Percentage of schools with ramp has been modified to percentage of schools required and have ramp.

After data was cleaned, each indicator was *normalised* by using the following formula:

$$NV_{ij} = 1 - \left[\frac{\{\text{Best } X_i - \text{Observed } X_{ij}\}}{\{\text{Best } X_i - \text{Worst } X_i\}} \right]$$

Upon receiving *normalised values*, *Principal Component Analysis* (PCA) was applied to decide the factor loading and weights. In case of a few variables, policy options were explored to identify the *best values* instead of based on the *observed values*. Some of these variables are: percentage of schools with pupil-teacher and student-classroom ratio above 30 and 35 (best value, zero), percentage of teachers without professional qualification (best value, zero) etc.

EDI in 2013-14 may not necessarily be comparable with the same in the previous year.

It must be conceded that the DISE does represent a significant advancement over the earlier systems of data collection, compilation, analysis and publications. In terms of reduction of time-lag and improvement of quality, it represents a phenomenal stride over all the other systems.

DISE can be said to have emerged as a time-tested 'model' to serve educational statistics. It must become the only system and shall be upgraded to cover Secondary and Senior Secondary stages also.

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The National University of Educational Planning and Administration has created a comprehensive database on elementary education in India under one of its most prestigious projects, known as, District Information System for Education (DISE). Off late, MIS for Secondary level of education has also been developed which covers both Secondary and Senior Secondary schools/sections of all the districts of the country. What is more remarkable about DISE/SEMIS is that it has drastically reduced the time-lag in availability of educational statistics which is now down from 7-8 years to less than a year at the national and only a few months at the district and state levels.

The National University has successfully developed School Report Cards of more than 1.45 million schools imparting Elementary education and about 237 thousand Secondary and Higher Secondary schools. In addition to quantitative information, the Report Cards also provide qualitative information and a descriptive report about individual schools. And, all that can now be accessed with the click of a mouse. Even school-specific raw data has also been provided online to users.

The Report Cards are produced to provide users comprehensive information on all the vital parameters, be it student, teacher or school related variables, yet concise, accurate information about each school in a standard format which is easy to understand and allows meaningful comparisons to be made among schools. We hope that these reports are used in constructive conversations which lead to improved education for all children across the country.
